Potential Changes to Free School Meals Eligibility

Currently, any child found eligible for free school meals enjoys protected status under transitional protection arrangements, meaning they remain eligible until the end of their current phase of education. However, there has been speculation in the press recently that this protection may soon end, possibly on 31st March, 2025. If protections do cease, those found eligible AFTER this date would lose their Free School Meal status immediately upon any change in circumstances.

Surrey County Council have advised us they estimate there are over 2,000 families in Surrey that if checked, would likely be found eligible for free school meals, but who aren't currently accessing this entitlement. We would encourage parents to check their eligibility as soon as possible by completing and returning the attached Application Form to the School Office for processing.

Finally, can I please remind everyone that the school car parks are for staff only (even before and after school). We are seeing a growing number of parents try to use our car parks to drop off children – space in both is tight and one parent nearly ran over their own child in their rush to reverse and leave this week!
