- **The introduction of our OPAL activities to enhance lunchtime play.**
- **The range of opportunities our children have to experience and compete in inter-school competitions and festivals**
- **The continued benefits to well being that our internal enrichment and enhanced pastoral support offers our pupils (including our Forest School programme).**
